- **The McCain Institute Policy Design Studio and Internship Program**
 - A partnership that allows for students to intern in Washington DC for a semester while participating in specialized lectures and presentations.
- **Capital Scholars Program**
 - A summer internship program that facilitates students to live and intern in Washington DC.
- **Pi Sigma Alpha: The National Political Science Honor Society**
 - The academic honor society for Political Science and Global Studies students with a focus on community service and academic success.
- **SPGS Bachelor of Arts/Master of Arts in Political Science Program**
 - The 4+1 competitive program that allows students to complete both their BA in Political Science or Global Studies and MA in Political Science within 5 years.
- **Junior Fellows Program**
 - An upper division undergraduate program. Students are a Research or Teaching Assistant and earn upper division credits.
- **Study Abroad - Summer, Fall, Spring**
- **Arizona Legislative Internship Program**
 - An internship at Arizona State government agencies - receive a tuition waiver, full-time internship credits, and a stipend.
- **The US State Department (Diplomat in Residence)**
 - US Ambassador who counsels students interested in interning or working in foreign affairs for the US State Department.

- **Faculty Teaching Introductory Courses**
 - Students in beginning courses are taught by full-time faculty, promoting discussion and fostering interest in the field.

 - Model United Nations is an authentic simulation of the UN General Assembly, UN Security Council, or other multilateral body, which introduces students to the world of diplomacy, negotiation, and decision making.
